International Baccalaureate

The International Baccalaureate

Program at Land O' Lakes High School serves students throughout the central and eastern part of Pasco County. Enrollment is currently at 360 students, 9th – 12th grade. IB is a rigorous academic program designed to meet international standards that also instills a sense of "international-mindedness" in every student. Students are tested externally through essay exams during their 11th and 12th grade years. Students are admitted to this program by an application process. The program consists of 4 years of intensive study in English, math, history, foreign language, experimental sciences, and an academic elective. Students must also complete three core elements of IB, which are a Theory of Knowledge course, a 4000-word essay, and 150 hours of service to the community. Forty-six students graduated from this program in July 2012.

Results of IB testing, June 2012
386 IB tests were taken by 46 students.
Of the 46 IB students, 78% received the IB diploma. The remaining 10 received an IB certificate for tests passed. 5 IB students were National Merit Finalists and 3 were National Merit Commended.

Since 2003, 100% of our IB students have been accepted to college.
