- Most Academy/CTE programs give students a chance for industry certification upon completion of the course pathway
- Students need to reference the graduation requirements below when selecting classes. Students should select alternate course options for their electives that they would be willing to take in the event that one of their top choices fills up or is no longer going to be offered.
- 9th grade students who are interested in doing a Dual Enrollment (DE) course MUST meet the eligibility requirements listed below <u>before May 2024</u> to be eligible to take DE courses in the fall. Students taking a DE course online or through PHSC would have a "PHSC Off Campus Placeholder" on their schedule, and <u>must have daily transportation</u>. Students cannot stay on campus at all during an off-campus placeholder. Off-campus placeholders must be at the beginning or end of the day. Students who meet eligibility requirements and plan to take a DE course must contact School Counselor (cmoody@pasco.k12.fl.us) about this request. Additional steps are required to participate in DE.
