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## MYSTUDENT

The myStudent portal is used to see grades, attendance, schedules, report cards, etc.

- **Steps to Access myStudent**
  - Go to [mypascoconnect.pasco.k12.fl.us](http://mypascoconnect.pasco.k12.fl.us)
  - Click on "Sign in to myPascoConnect"
  - Sign in with the following credentials:
    - Username: Student Number
    - Password: myPascoConnect Password (i.e., Stars21#)
  - Click on myStudent app

**Parents:** We recommend that you sign on to the myStudent system to follow your child's progress in each class. To establish a myStudent parent account, visit <http://www.pasco.k12.fl.us/parents> and select "myStudent" under the "School/Classroom Resources" section. You can also email teachers directly. Email addresses can be found on the LOLHS website or on myStudent.

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## STUDENT EMAIL ADDRESSES

All students have a district-assigned student email address. Important information is sent to this email (i.e., location/date/time for when a student is scheduled for testing). Students are encouraged to check it regularly.

## PARKING PASSES

The parking application opens on July 1st before each school year. Students must be on-track for graduation and have no financial obligations to the school in order to qualify for a parking pass. Completing the application does NOT guarantee that the school will issue a parking pass/spot. Priority is given to 12th graders, then 11th graders. If space is available, eligible 10th graders can petition the 10th grade Assistant Principal for consideration.
