# Tardy Policies



#### **Tier 1 Interventions**

○ 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Unexcused Tardies-Verbal Warning.

#### **Tier 2 Interventions**

- 3<sup>rd</sup> Unexcused Tardies = Lunch Detention and Parent Contact
- 4<sup>th</sup> Unexcused Tardies = Lunch Detention (or after school detention and will receive loss of privilege for that day) and Parent Contact

#### **Tier 3 Interventions**

 5<sup>th</sup> or more Unexcused Tardy = Referral issued. 1 day ISS and the student is ineligible to participate in any cocurricular or extracurricular activity for a period of time not to exceed 5 days.

# Dress Code Policy

#### **Requirements**

- Fabric in front, back and on the sides.
- Shoes (No Slippers)
- Shirts must have straps and extend to waist
- Clothing must cover undergarments
- No Pajamas
- No Hats
- Profanity, drugs, alcohol, violence or vulgar content is not allowed on clothing

 Taking unauthorized pictures or videos is not allowed on campus.


Students are responsible for their own devices. Do not lend your phone or borrow a phone from another student.
