	We will do our best to honor students' first choices of electives. The remaining elective choices will be considered as alternate if the top elective choice does not fit in the schedule or is not available. If a student selects a course as an option on this sheet and is assigned to that class, we will not accommodate a schedule change request in the fall to remove them from it. The requested courses are dependent on grade level, availability, class size, and student qualifications (prerequisites).		
•	Students cannot pick their teachers, class periods, or lunch period. Please choose courses carefully since it likely will not be possible to change the courses later.		
•	If a student wants to take an online class, they can choose to take it in our on-campus eSchool lab or off-campus. If a student chooses to go off campus, the off-campus placeholder must be at the beginning or the end of the day <b>AND</b> the student must have <u>daily transportation</u> . Students cannot stay on campus at all during an off-campus placeholder. Depending on availability, students may not be able to have more than one period in the on-campus eSchool lab. <u>Students can have a maximum of 3 eSchool placeholders</u> .

Off-campus placeh	tudents who are interested in doing a Dual Enrollment (DE) course MUST meet the eligibility requirements <a href="mailto:before May 2025">before May 2025</a> to eable to take DE courses in the fall. Students taking a DE course online or through PHSC will have a "PHSC Off Campus laceholder" on their schedule, and <a href="mailto:must have daily transportation">must have daily transportation</a> . Students cannot stay on campus at all during an off-campus laceholder. Off-campus placeholders must be at the beginning or end of the day. Additional steps are required to participate in E.
