# Graduation Requirements

- ▶ 24 credits
  - ▶ 4 English
  - ▶ 4 Math
  - ▶ 4 Social Science
  - ▶ 4 Science
  - ▶ 4 World Language
  - ▶ 2 Pre-IB Electives (Inquiry Skills & Sophomore Elective)
  - ▶ 1 IB Elective (11<sup>th</sup>)
  - ▶ 1 Theory of Knowledge

## ALSO REQUIRED FOR HS GRADUATION:

- IB Core
  - Creativity-Activity-Service (CAS)
  - Extended Essay (EE)
  - Theory of Knowledge (TOK)
- 2.0 Unweighted GPA
- Algebra 1 assessment
- Grade 10 ELA assessment

# IB Diploma Basics

- Creativity-Activity-Service (CAS) – Input, evidence, document, signatures, reflect
- Theory of Knowledge – Paper and presentation (IA)
- Extended Essay – Deep inquiry and research and to write something intelligent, unique, provocative in thought, and well edited

***ALL components must be completed in order to earn your high school diploma!***

# IB Diploma Basics – Point System

- 6 IB Courses + TOK
  - 1 or 2 courses in 11th grade (IB elective and possibly math)
  - 4-5 courses in 12<sup>th</sup> grade + TOK
- For each subject, you can earn up to 7 points, earned through Internal and External Assessments
- 24 total points needed to earn the diploma, including bonus points from EE/TOK
- At least 12 points must be earned in Higher Level (HL) courses, which must include:
  - Biology
  - History
  - English Literature
- Optional 4<sup>th</sup> HL courses:
  - Spanish
  - French

# Why take a 4<sup>th</sup> HL?

- ▶ IB will take the top 3 scores from HL courses
- ▶ If you're particularly strong in French or Spanish, the extra HL course could boost your total HL points
- ▶ All points still count towards overall total (24 points needed)

- Choose World Language Class
  - IB French 4 or AP French
  - IB Spanish 4 or AP Spanish
- Choose math course based on current enrollment and teacher recommendation
  - IB Precalculus
  - IB Math Analysis and Interpretations
  - IB Math Applications and Interpretations
- Rank IB Electives 1 → 4
