Meeting the PE Requirement:

- 0.5 Credit of Personal Fitness (Online) + 0.5 Credit of Outdoor Education (Online) or Fitness Lifestyle Design (Online)
- 0.5 Credit of Personal Fitness (Online) + Marching Band Waiver***
- Waiver from 2 seasons of a JV or Varsity sport at LOLHS***
- ***<u>IMPORTANT</u>: You do not earn credit for waivers, so you would need to complete extra elective credits.

Highly recommend that students take HOPE during freshman year.

FINE/PRACTICAL ART

- Many students take Fine Art during freshman year. Fine Art can be satisfied a number of ways.
- Any course on the course card that has a
 symbol meets the Fine Art requirement.
- NOTE: Some courses require after school commitment (e.g., practice, recitals, performances).
- Prior experience is not required for Band, Dance, or Chorus.







 if the top elective choice does not fit in the schedule or is not available. If a student selects a course as an option on this sheet
 and is assigned to that class, we will not accommodate a schedule change request in the fall to remove them from it. The
 requested courses are dependent on grade level, availability, class size, and student qualifications (prerequisites).
- Students cannot pick their teachers, class periods, or lunch period. Please choose courses carefully since it likely will not be
 possible to change the courses later.
- If a student wants to take an online class, they can choose to take it in our on-campus eschapillab or off-campus. If a student chooses to go off campus, the off-campus placeholder must be at the beginning or the end of the day AND the student must have daily transportation. Students cannot stay on campus at all during an off-campus placeholder. Depending on availability, students may not be able to have more than one period in the en-campus eschool placeholders.
- Students who are interested in doing a Dual Enrollment (DE) course MUST meet the eligibility requirements <u>before May 2025</u> to
 be able to take DE courses in the fall. Students taking a DE course online or through PHSC will have a "PHSC Off Campus
 Placeholder" on their <u>schedule, and must have daily transportation</u>. Students cannot stay on campus at all during an off-campus
 placeholder. Off-campus placeholders must be at the beginning or end of the day. Additional steps are required to participate in
