The learner profiles are qualities that the IB aims to develop in students who are going through the program.

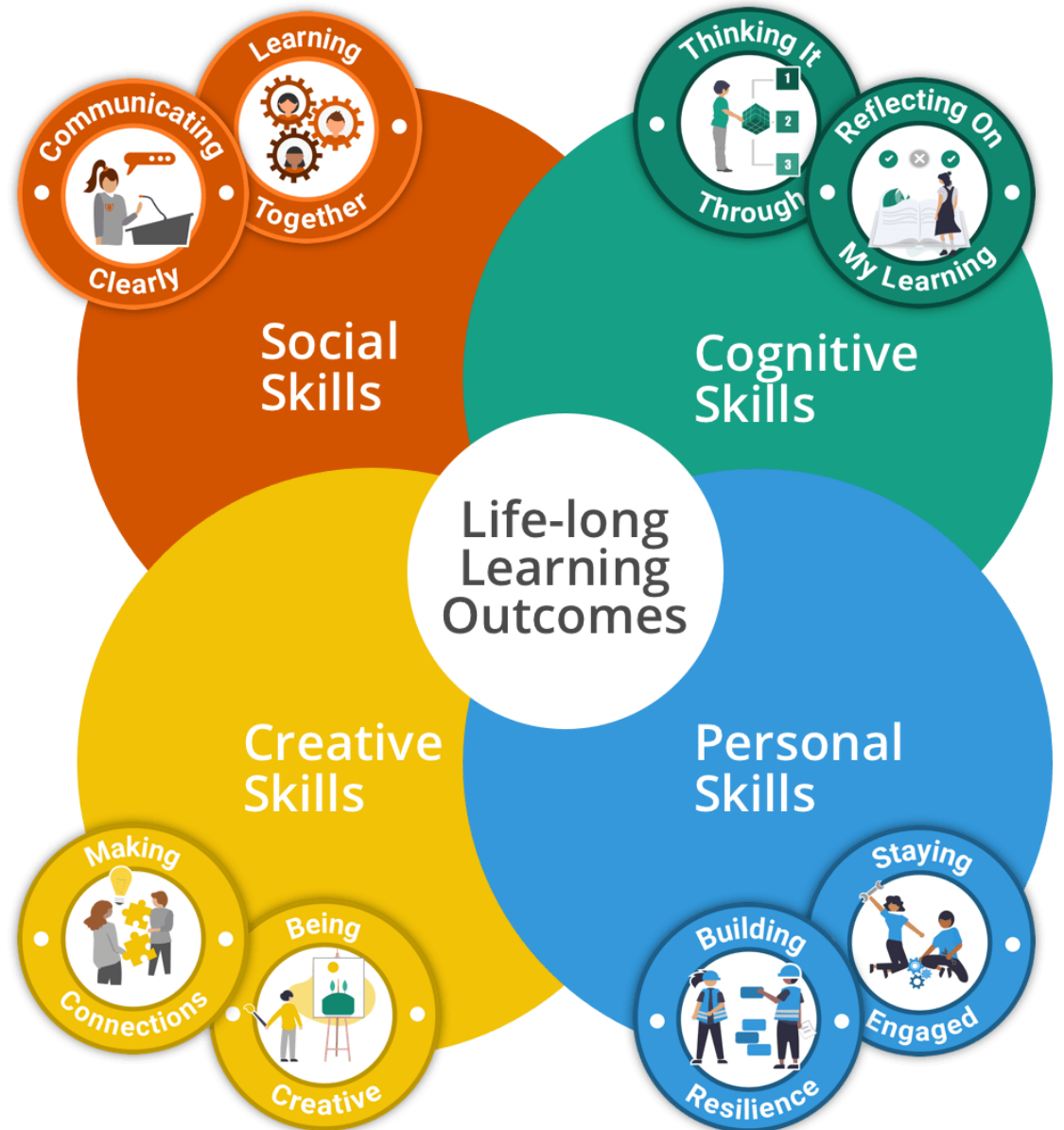

IB Diploma Years Overview

- Classes in grades 9 and 10 will be Pre-IB courses.
- IB Diploma Years are grades 11 and 12
 - Six academic subject assessments
 - Extended essay (EE)
 - Creativity – Activity – Service (CAS)
 - Theory of Knowledge (TOK)



Land O' Lakes IB Program Model

- Pre-IB grades 9 and 10
- IB Rigor – Honors and AP Courses

 - Critical inquiry approach to learning
 - Deep reading and reflection
 - Refined literary and analytical writing
 - Thoughtful spoken expression

What IB Leads to...

- Students can earn the **IB Diploma** – which is widely recognized by colleges and universities, both domestic and international.
- If you earn the diploma, you can earn up to **60 college credits** (about half of the required credits to graduate).
- The majority of our students have **significant scholarships** toward their college career.

TRANSPORTATION
