Should this trip or event be cancelled as a result of such an event, the District cannot guarantee any monies (including deposits) will be refunded by the vendor(s) associated with this transaction. Therefore, students, parents, guardians, etc., are hereby cautioned and advised that the District will not be liable for any reimbursements associated with this event that are not refunded by the vendor(s) and returned to the District.

As a student participating in a field trip, I agree to conduct myself in accordance with the District School Board of Pasco County *Student Code of Conduct* and all established policies. Specific to this field trip, the following requirements apply:

1. Students must stay within the established limitations set by the trip sponsor.
2. Students must cooperate with and follow the guidelines provided by the trip sponsor, chaperones, and/or tour guides.
3. Students are prohibited from possessing or using alcohol, tobacco, drugs, toxic vapors, or any type of weapons.
4. Proper attire is expected, and the trip sponsor has the final decision-making authority.
5. Profanity, obscene language, and gestures are strictly prohibited.
6. Bullying, hazing, and initiation activities are not allowed.
7. Students will adhere to all "buddy" or group assignments and must remain within permitted areas.
8. No lewd behavior or public displays of affection are permitted.
9. Property vandalism and theft from stores or other locations are strictly prohibited. Additionally, the student and parent/guardian will be expected to pay full restitution if any property is vandalized or taken.
10. Punctuality is required. It is the student's responsibility to follow the itinerary and adhere to scheduled activity times.
11. Students will assist in loading, unloading, and setting up any necessary equipment.

Failure to comply with the *Student Code of Conduct* and/or field trip expectations may result in consequences listed therein that document and/or a combination thereof:

1. The student may be assigned a chaperone for the remainder of the trip, forfeiting participation in all remaining activities.
2. A mandatory meeting with a parent/guardian, the student, the trip sponsor, and administration will be held upon return to discuss potential consequences, including possible suspension or recommendation for expulsion.
3. The student may be sent home at their own expense. Arrangements for adult supervision during the student's trip home may require the cost of an accompanying adult.
4. The loss of all costs associated with the field trip; no refunds will be provided.

Additional expectations specific to this field trip may be attached to this form. Both the student and parent/guardian are expected to understand and comply with these additional requirements.
